Ground Rules

The first time you meet, it's essential to lay down some ground rules. Every crew member should agree to these basic values as the framework for your time together.

INTENTIONALITY: Our crew agrees to meet regularly. (Sounds simple but it requires commitment.)

PERMISSION: As a crew, we give each other permission to speak into each other's lives in love. That means we need to be able to trust one another and understand that everything that's shared in our crew is completely confidential.

DIRECTION: Crew members are committed to holding fast to the vision of growing deeper in our relationship with Jesus and one another.

Grow Deeper

Each crew will move at its own pace getting to know one another and growing deeper into community with each other. As you come together – over coffee, a meal or for a walk – you may find it helpful to ask one another these questions:

1. How's your First 20 going? Are you spending time with God each morning?
2. What is God saying to you through His Word and by His Spirit?
3. What do you sense God wanting to change in you?
4. What has God called you to this season?
5. How are you stewarding what has been entrusted to you (such as relationships, talents and material possessions)?
